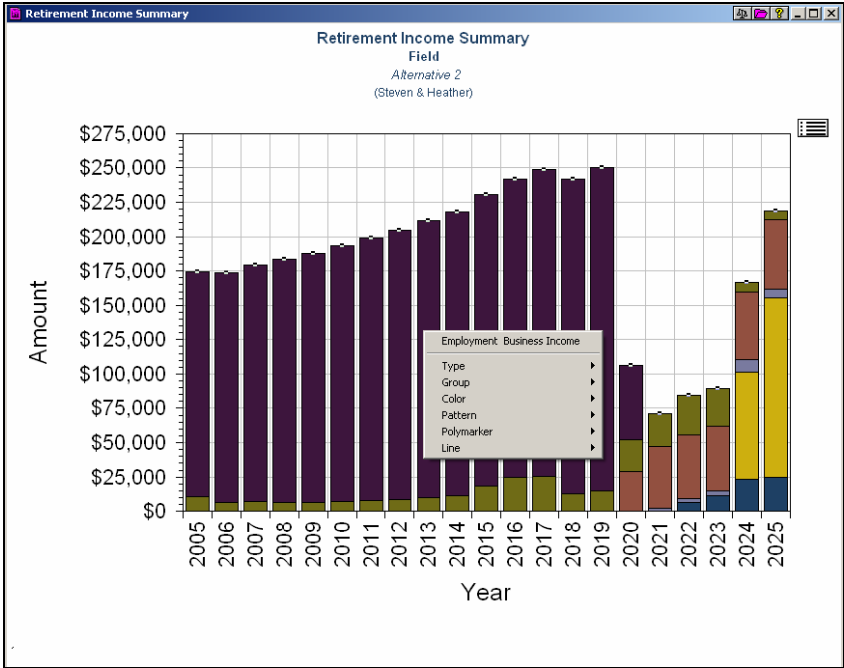


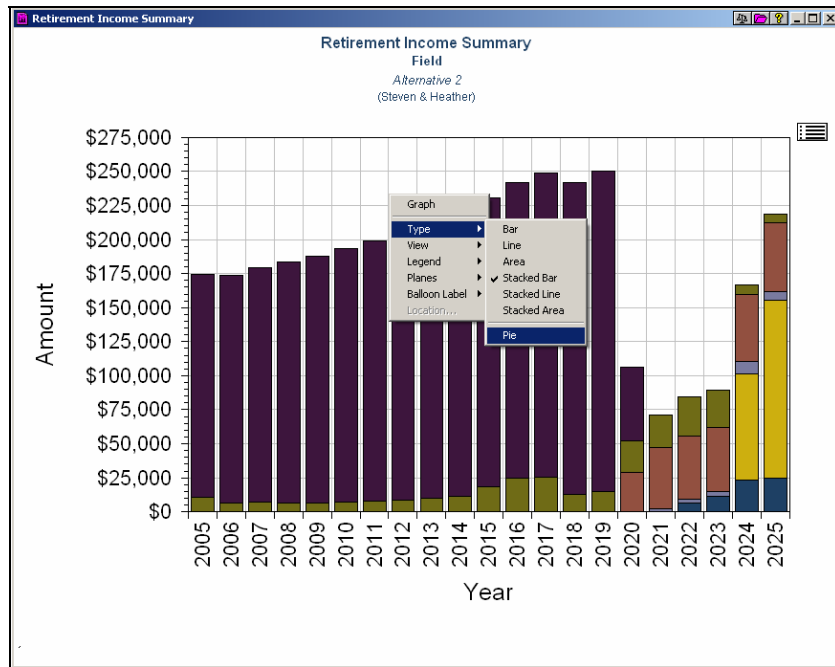
Change the appearance of a graph to suit your needs

From the *Graphs* menu, select the graph you would like to create.

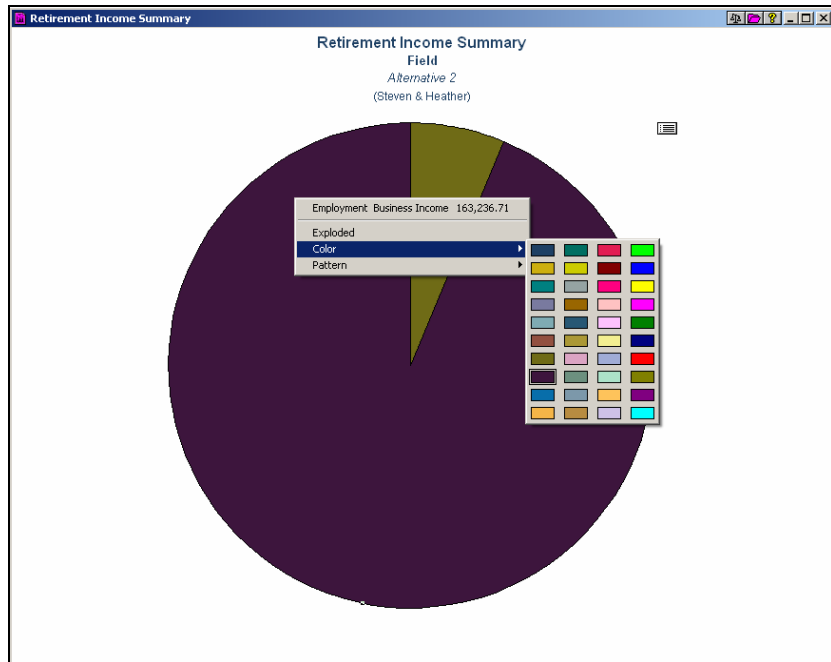
Once the graph has been generated, right-click the graph to display a list of options you can use to change the graph. You can change the type, group, colour, pattern, polymarker, or line options.



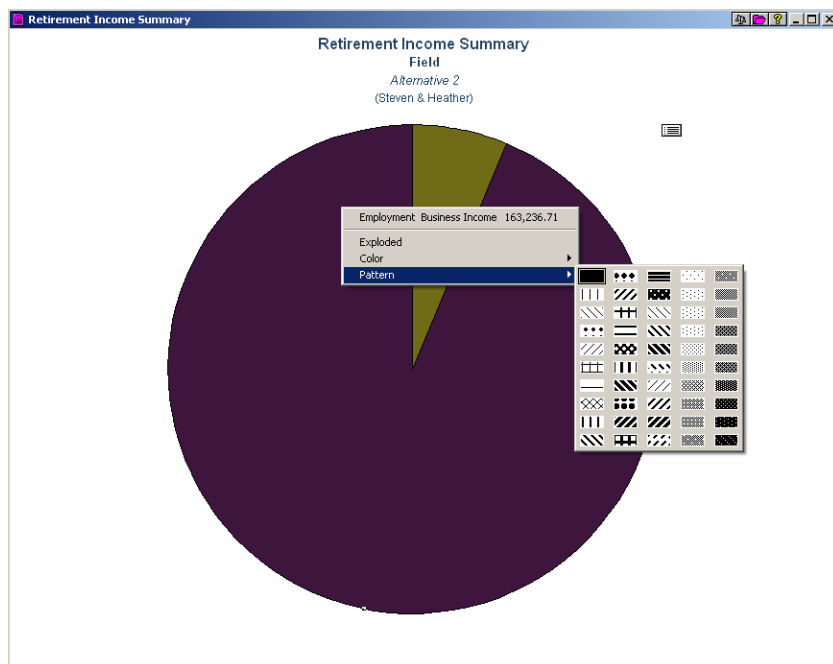
This example shows you how to change the type to *Pie*. From the menu, select **Type – Pie**.



This example shows you how to change the color of the graph sections, bars, or lines. First, right-click one of the graph sections and then choose **Color** from the menu. When the colour selection box appears, choose the colour you want to use for that graph section.



You can also change the pattern of the graph. Right-click one of the graph sections, and then select **Pattern** from the menu. Unique patterns can be selected for each individual section of the graph.



To print your graphs, minimize the graph window to an icon on your desktop and drag-and-drop the graph icon onto the *Printer* icon. The *Printer* dialog box opens and allows you to change the settings for the current printer or choose a different printer. If you want to print the graph in colour, select a colour printer from the *Device* list, and then in the *Options* section, select **Color** from the *Color* list. When you have finished changing the printer options and properties, click **Print**.
