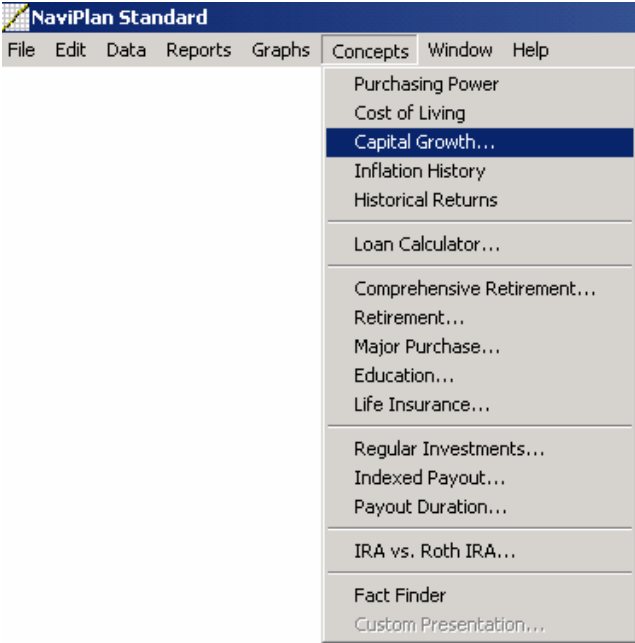


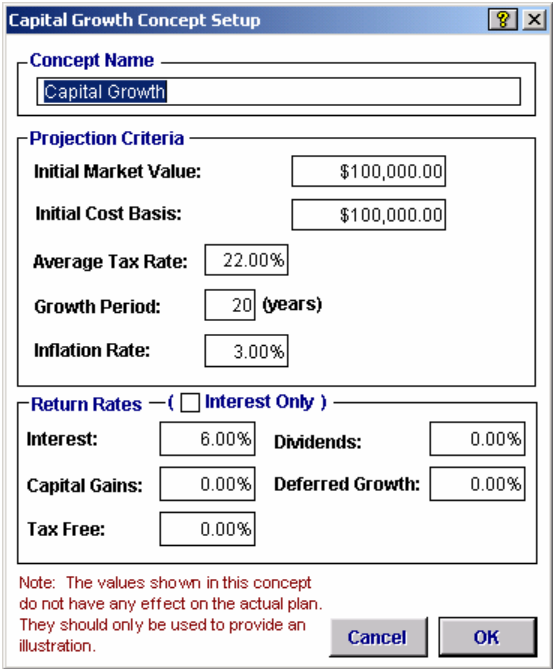
Duplicating and renaming concepts

You have always been able to duplicate NaviPlan concepts, but now you can also rename the duplicated concept to differentiate it from the original.

Go to the **Concepts** menu, and then select the NaviPlan concept you want to create.

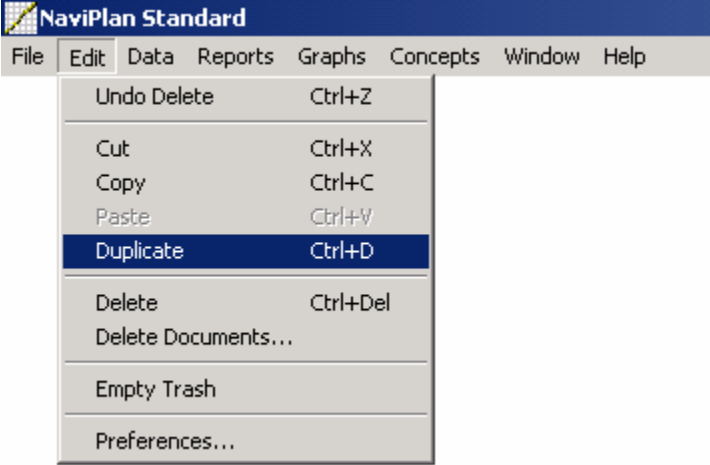


The concept's dialog box opens. Enter the appropriate data.

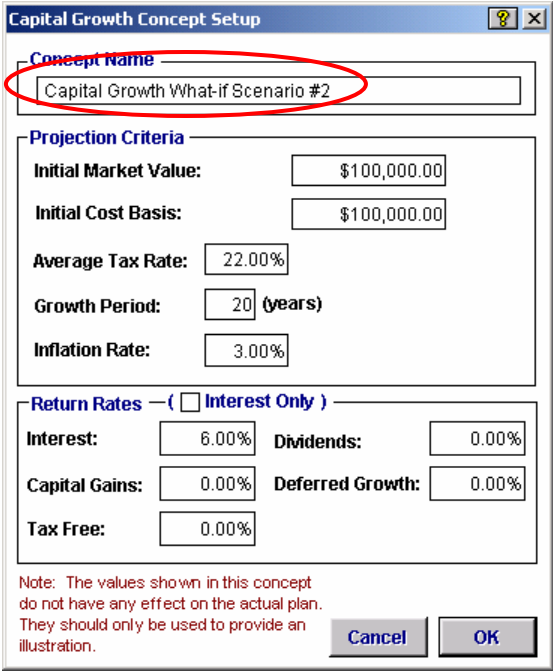


Once the data has been entered, click **OK**. The appropriate report, table, or graph displays on the screen.

Duplicate the concept to create another What-if scenario. Right-click the blue title bar of the concept, or select **Edit** from the menu bar at the top of the screen.



After the concept has been duplicated, click the **Edit** button for the new concept. You create another What-if scenario by changing the name of the new concept, and the variables you entered.



After you've changed the name and variables, click **OK** to accept the changes, minimize the concept, and return to the NaviPlan desktop. The new concept is now differentiated from the original by its unique name.
